

Present situation of the international cooperation

Japanese Police have been executing the variety of international cooperation as follows.

1 ODA (Official Development Assistance)

Based on ODA, Japanese Police have been executing the international cooperation jointed with JICA, Japan International Cooperation Agency, to the following countries and fields for example.

- Assistance for the reform of Indonesian National Police
- Assistance for improvement of drug law enforcement in Thailand and neighboring countries
- Assistance for the criminal investigation and identification in the Philippines

We also assist other countries by introducing “Koban” system, traffic management, etc. The assistance consists of:

- 1) Acceptance of trainees from foreign countries
- 2) Dispatch of experts to foreign countries
- 3) Grant aid and/or equipment assistance to foreign countries

2 International relief activity for large-scale disasters

Japanese Police have dispatched JDR (Japan Disaster Relief) teams to large-scale disasters overseas 9 times since the governing law was enacted in 1987. JDR teams trained for quick and effective operation.



3 Civilian police activity of PKO, Peace Keeping Operation

Since 1992, Japanese Police have dispatched 78 police officers in total for the advice and guidance to Cambodian and EastTimor local police.
