

Child Seats Save Children

Child seats protect small children from injury in traffic accidents.

Make sure that you use child seats when you drive with small children.

Vehicle drivers are legally prohibited from driving with small children under six years old without child seats.

If you do not use a child seat, a tragedy such as shown in the photo below could occur in the event of an accident!

How to use child seats properly

Improper use of child seats renders them ineffective. Therefore, use the seats properly by following the instruction manual and other documents. The proper use of child seats is as follows:

- Choose child seats that suit the size of your children and that allow you to fix them firmly in the seat.
- If your vehicle is equipped with an air bag for the front passenger seat, use child seats in the back seat whenever possible. If you have no other choice but to use one in the front passenger seat, move the seat as far back as possible and make sure to fix the child seat so that it faces forward.
- Ensure that child seats are fixed firmly to the seat.
