This report (White Paper) states policies for crime victims, etc. formulated by the government based on Article 10 of the Basic Act on Crime Victims, and was submitted to the Diet, as an annual report.

This White Paper is the 16th report. Chapter 1 features the formulation of the Fourth Basic Plan for Crime Victims, etc. (decided by the Cabinet on March 30, 2021), and Chapter 2 describes the policies taken for crime victims, etc. in FY2020 and their progress, in line with the five priorities, based on the Third Basic Plan for Crime Victims, etc. (decided by the Cabinet on April 1, 2016)
