This report (White Paper), the 17th in series, describes the measures taken for crime victims, etc. in FY2021 and the progress achieved, in line with the five priorities, based on the Fourth Basic Plan for Crime Victims, etc. (decided by the Cabinet on March 30, 2021; (hereinafter referred to as the "Fourth Basic Plan").
