This report compiles the Measures for Crime Victims taken by the government as the annual report to the Diet pursuant to the Article 10 of the Basic Act on Crime Victims (Act No. 161, 2004).

This ninth white paper consists of two chapters. Chapter 1 features major contacts to lead to the support corresponding to individual victim's circumstance. Chapter 2 lists the measures for crime victims taken during the fiscal year 2013 pursuant to the Second Basic Plan for Crime Victims (decided by the Cabinet on March 2011) in the order of the five priorities raised in the Plan.
