

Scoring Method of Cognitive Assessment

Calculation of the total score and determination of the result

1. Calculation of the total score

The total score is calculated by converting the scores on the cued recall test and temporal orientation test into the following formula.

(Formula)

$$\text{Total score} = 2.499 \times A + 1.336 \times B$$

A: Score on cued recall test

B: Score on temporal orientation

2. Determination of the result

The testee is determined to either have risk of dementia or have no risk of dementia according to the total score.

A: If the total score is less than 36 points, the testee is determined to “have risk of dementia.”

B: If the total score is 36 points or more, the testee is determined to “have no risk of dementia.”
