

# Details on the 7th Specialist Group Meeting on Child Sexual Exploitation

## 1. Aim

The aim is to further promote efforts to prevent child sexual exploitation by sharing mutual information and knowledge among related agencies, private groups, etc. involved in various efforts to prevent child sexual exploitation from their respective perspectives and positions.

#### a. Progressive measures in the prevention of child sexual exploitation [National Police Agency & Aichi Prefectural Police]

In response to the currently situation that the number of victimized children caused by social media remains high level, the presentation was given on the police efforts to "promote alerts and warning to prevent sexual exploitation of children caused by social media". In addition to the outline of the activity and its effects, the current efforts in actual cases involving Aichi Prefectural Police were presented.



#### b. Efforts to prevent sexual offender recidivism

##### [Department of Neuropsychiatry, St. Marianna University School of Medicine]

In view of research conducted in various areas regarding forensic psychiatry, the presentation titled "Update on Sex Offender Treatment in Japan – Therapeutic Intervention Approach for Sex Offenders Development and Application of SPiRiTS" described activities to prevent sex offenders from repeating offenses effectively, the development and implementation of SPiRiTS, a sex offender prevention program that is feasible in the Japanese communities.

#### c. Support activity for children by NPO : Creating places and healthy upbringing, etc. for children

##### [Nonprofit Organization BOND PROJECT]

The presentation titled "Support for Young Women in Japan" described the all-round support given on a long-term basis to young women in their teens and twenties who face difficulties in life, the coordination of activities with other organizations and other concrete measures implemented, such as online patrol.
